- 2. The reporting time for the Driving Test shall be 09.30 AM for Batch-I candidates and 12.30 PM for Batch-II candidates on the respective days.
- 3. It is further notified for the information of candidates that:
 - i. Admit Cards for the candidates appearing for the Driving Test shall be hosted on official website of J&K Services Selection Board (<u>www.jkssb.nic.in</u>) from 28-03-2025.
 - ii. Candidates can download their Admit Cards from the website by using their Name or Application Number. They must read the instructions contained therein, carefully.
 - iii. In case of any difficulty in downloading/issues related to Admit Card, candidate(s) may contact the JKSSB Help-Desk at 0191-2461335 (Jammu)/0194-2435089 (Srinagar), during office hours.
 - iv. The candidates are also advised to stay in touch with the JKSSB's official website (www.jkssb.nic.in) for the latest updates on the examinations and Admit Cards will not be sent by post.
 - v. Candidates are advised to bring Admit Card, valid Driving License along-with one original photo ID Proof i.e. Aadhar card/Voter Card/Pan Card/Passport etc. mandatorily on the day of driving test.
 - vi. Candidate shall be allowed to appear in the driving test only once.
 - vii. Candidates are required to appear before the driving test committee(s) on the schedule date, time and venue. A candidate, who fails to appear in the driving test on the given date, shall not be put to driving test later and such candidate shall forfeit his/her right of consideration at any stage.
 - viii. Candidates are being called for the driving test provisionally and only such candidates shall be allowed to appear in the driving test, who are in possession

M 27/3 of valid qualification, other certificate(s) including Driving License as on the cut-

off date for filling of application form.

ix. In case of any deficiency with reference to eligibility etc., proved at the time of driving test, the candidate shall not be allowed to appear in the driving test. If any deficiency is found subsequently, the candidate shall not be considered for selection and will be treated as disqualified.

x. Any candidate found guilty of impersonating or submitting fabricated/tampered documents/testimonials or making false and incorrect statements or suppressing material information shall render him/her liable for criminal prosecution under law, which shall include permanent debarment or debarment for a specific period, for consideration of any or all recruitments, made by the Board. Also canvassing/lobbying in any form will entail disqualification of the candidate.

xi. The Board reserves the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate at any

stage at which he/she is found ineligible.

xii. Any candidate found misleading the Board/Committee(s) by trying to appear more than once, in the driving test shall be liable for prosecution under norms. And in cases, where a candidate appears in the Driving test, more than once, he/she shall be declared "Failed" and shall attract further action in terms of the Rules/Regulations.

xiii. The Driving Test is of qualifying nature and only the candidate(s) who qualify the Driving Test shall be considered for the Written Test.

xiv. No TA/DA shall be paid for participation in the Driving Test.

4. Stepwise procedure to download JKSSB E-Admit Card:

i. To download E-Admit Card, first visit the official website of JKSSB, i.e. www.jkssb.nic.in.

ii. On the homepage, there will be an option to download E-Admit Card.

iii. On that page, click on the Download Admit Card Button.

iv. You can download your E-Admit Card by using either Name along-with other details or using Application Number.

v. Click on the 'View and Print E-Admit Card' button.

vi. The JKSSB E-Admit Card will appear on the screen.

vii. Download and print your JKSSB E-Admit Card.

viii. Candidate must bring the clear printed copy of E-Admit Card on the day of their Driving Test.
